**BIO:** Alberta singer/songwriter Robb Moss has been writing songs his entire life and in 2012 stepped back from a career in the Canadian oil patch to record and produce his debut album, **Sometimes We Win**. The songs Fools Gold and When Someone Goes Away went on to receive International, Canadian and US airplay on Roots, NPR, Country, Internet and Americana radio stations.

In May 2013, Robb's song, When Someone Goes Away was included in a musical tribute to the late **George Jones** on Lyon Premiere 90.2 FM in France. Other songwriters on the tribute included Terry Clark, Patty Loveless, Toby Keith and Alan Jackson.

In the spring of 2013, Robb was selected as a finalist in the **Calgary Folk Festival** song-writing competition along with a number of notable Alberta songwriters including 100 Mile House, Lucas Chaisson, John Wort Hannam, Amy Theissen and Tim Buckley.



In 2014, Robb ventured to Nashville to record and produce his second CD, **Wish I Wrote that Song**, which was released February 1, 2015. The album features an all-star cast of musicians including guitarist Kenny Greenberg (Kenny Chesney), keyboardist Jimmy Nichols (Kenny Chesney, Faith Hill) and vocalist Kim Parent (Faith Hill).

Robb's musical influences reach as far back as Gram Parsons and follow the development of such varied artists as Mark Knopfler, Tom Petty and Randy Newman. White Knight Music of New York recently described Robb's musical prowess as "smooth with a bit of gravel." The album has also garnered praise from the revered NSAI (Nashville Songwriters Association) that described elements of Robb's song-writing with words like "classic, anecdotal and nostalgic with new dimension, catchy, universal, poetic, eccentric and Yeah, Americana indeed."
